



The change in format for the Southwest Organizing School is moving full steam ahead. So far this school year we have taught, or are scheduled to teach, 25 courses around the country, from New York to California. But, we are still focusing on the Southwest, with courses given or scheduled in Nevada, Colorado, and New Mexico.

This new model has many advantages. First, the training is much more affordable, per participant. Second, this arrangement affords more flexibility, with the length and content more directly tailored to the concerns of those requesting the training. Finally, we offer courses in a more timely fashion, once the need for the training has been determined, because we are not bound to an annual pre-arranged schedule.

The NLC fee for offering classes is based on the number of days the course runs at \$1,250 per day for instruction and \$750 per day for preparation plus expenses. The sponsoring unions or central bodies arrange for the facilities.
